








<u>Covid Care Services - Food Kit Preparation during Covid Lockdown- from April 2020 to</u> <u>December 2020</u>

NSS volunteers of St Dominic's College have played a crucial role in providing various services to support communities and mitigate the impact of the pandemic. Thave been actively involved in preparing Kits and distributing essential supplies to vulnerable communities. Civil Supplies Officer of Kanjirapally has asked **the help of NSS volunteers to prepare grocery kits for supply to the families during lockdown**. The same has been undertaken by NSS. 100 volunteers from the NSS unit worked for this activity from 15thApril onwards. The packing of grocery kits is being done up to November 2020 whenever requested. More than 45000 Kits were prepared by the NSS volunteers of St. Dominic's College and the Supplyco authorities appreciated the efforts taken by the volunteers even in the midst of the threat of Covid-19.












World Senior Citizens Day, 02nd august – Selfie with your Grandparent(s) Contest



Ramanujan Lecture Series II - Environment & its Resources - 16 September 2020.


