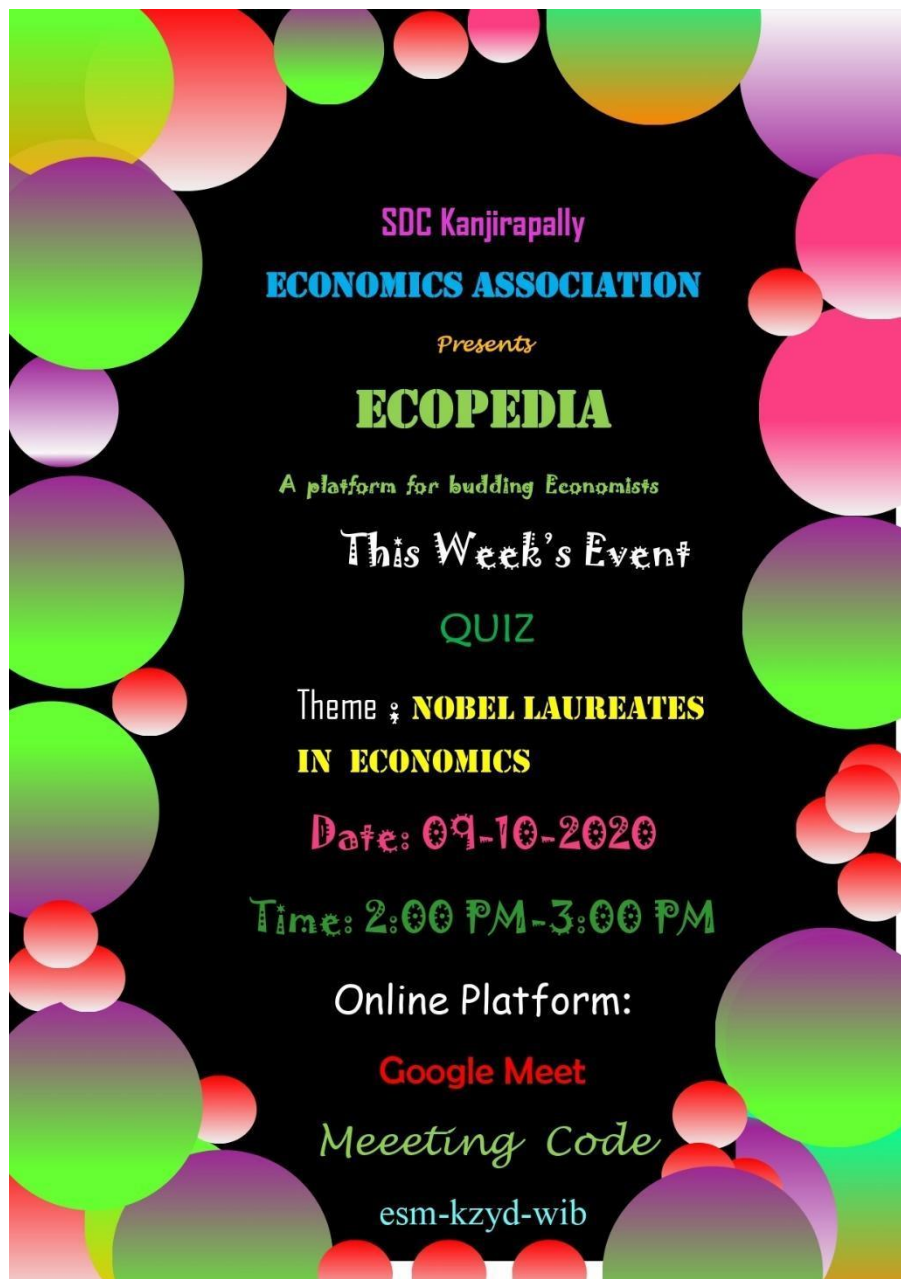

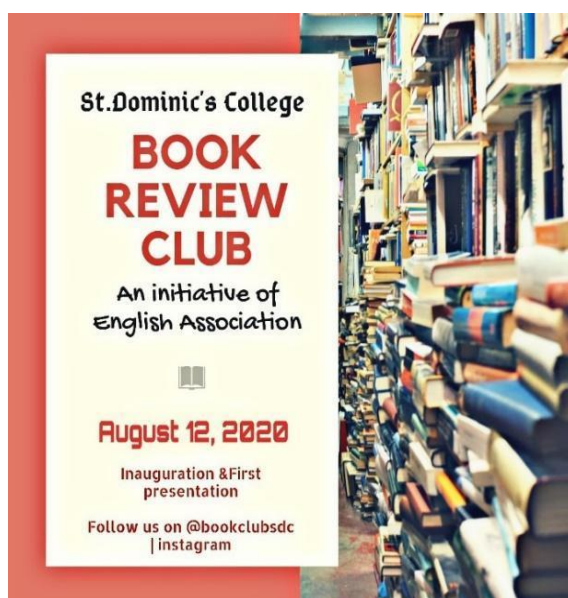
1. Books Review






4. Women's Self Defence Training Programme

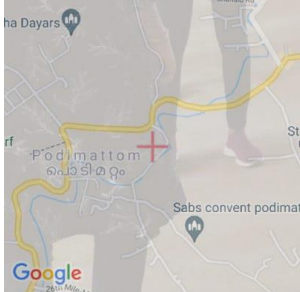
